

EXPLANATIONS WITH RESPECT TO CURRICULUM AND LATEST ADJUSTMENTS

1. The current curriculum students are entitled for graduation:

 2. Total ECTS points needed for graduation: **240 ECTS**
 3. SOFL/Second foreign language courses: At least 4 levels (of the same second foreign language course) must be completed successfully.
 4. **Total number of Area Elective courses (ELECT IR) needed for graduation: 12**
These courses are specified in the curriculum with the ELECT IR code.
 5. **Total number of University Elective courses (UNIV) needed for graduation: 3**
These courses are specified in the curriculum with the UNIV code.
 6. **Total number of UFND courses needed for graduation: 4 UFND + 1 Social Responsibility)**
 1. Sustainability
 2. Research Culture
 3. Ethic Culture
 4. Project Culture

+ UFND 7010 Social Responsibility
- Students attempting to take UFND courses for the first time are entitled to enrol on the afore-mentioned 4 UFND courses in order to graduate. Optionally, extra UFND courses could also be taken in consultation with academic advisors. Extra UFND and SOFL credits could be subtracted from the University Elective course load.
7. If the following (see below) were previously taken as a compulsory course, these courses could be counted as their new area elective equivalents (also indicated below) in the updated curriculum:
 - “INRL 204 International Politics/New: IR 2200”
 - “INRL 211 Contemporary State Systems/New: IR 2211”
 - “STAT 200 Statistical Analysis/New: Math 2200 Statistical Analysis
 8. If the following (see below) were previously taken as a compulsory course,

these courses could be counted as their new equivalents (also indicated below) in the updated curriculum:

- “ECON 102 Introduction to Economy II”
- “LAWS 085 Constitutional Law”
- “LAWS 274 International Public Law”

9. If “ECON 101 Introduction to Economics” was previously taken as a compulsory course, it would be counted as the compulsory course titled “ECON 1120 Essentials of Economics” in the new curriculum.

10. If “INRL 101 The History of Civilizations” was previously taken as a compulsory course, it would be counted as the compulsory course titled “IR 1102 History of Polity, Economy and Culture” in the new curriculum.

11. IR 3000 and IR 4000 Internship courses are also subtracted from the area elective course load. In case the student has taken both courses, only one of them is subtracted from the area elective course load. The other course is recorded with its own credit in the student’s transcript.

12. Extra area elective courses cannot be counted as university elective courses, and extra university elective courses cannot be counted as area elective courses.
